Tax Change Benefits Those Contributing to Living Legacy Foundation

The most recent tax act passed by Congress, titled the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012, included a renewal of a provision that allows a simple way for senior adults to make gifts to their church or other ministry organization.

The IRA Charitable Rollover was renewed through 2013. This reinstates the ability for individuals age 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ and above to make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) up to \$100k directly from an IRA to a charitable organization (other stipulations also apply). A QCD does not count as income, but there is no income tax deduction for the gift to charity. This is advantageous to individuals who don't itemize their deductions. The provision was established in 2006, but was allowed to expire at the end of 2011. Congress' most recent action makes the Charitable Rollover retroactive to January 1, 2012.
